



General information about the VRM guest ticket

The accommodation services within the VRM region participating in the VRM-Gästeticket scheme provide a special service for you during your stay! You will receive a VRM-Gästeticket from your accommodation service.

The VRM-Gästeticket is valid for the duration of your stay in the VRM. The VRM-Gästeticket cannot be purchased. You can only receive it from your host.

Your individual VRM-Gästeticket card is not transferable; only you personally may use the advantages provided by the ticket during your stay. Only the data entered by your host shall be valid.

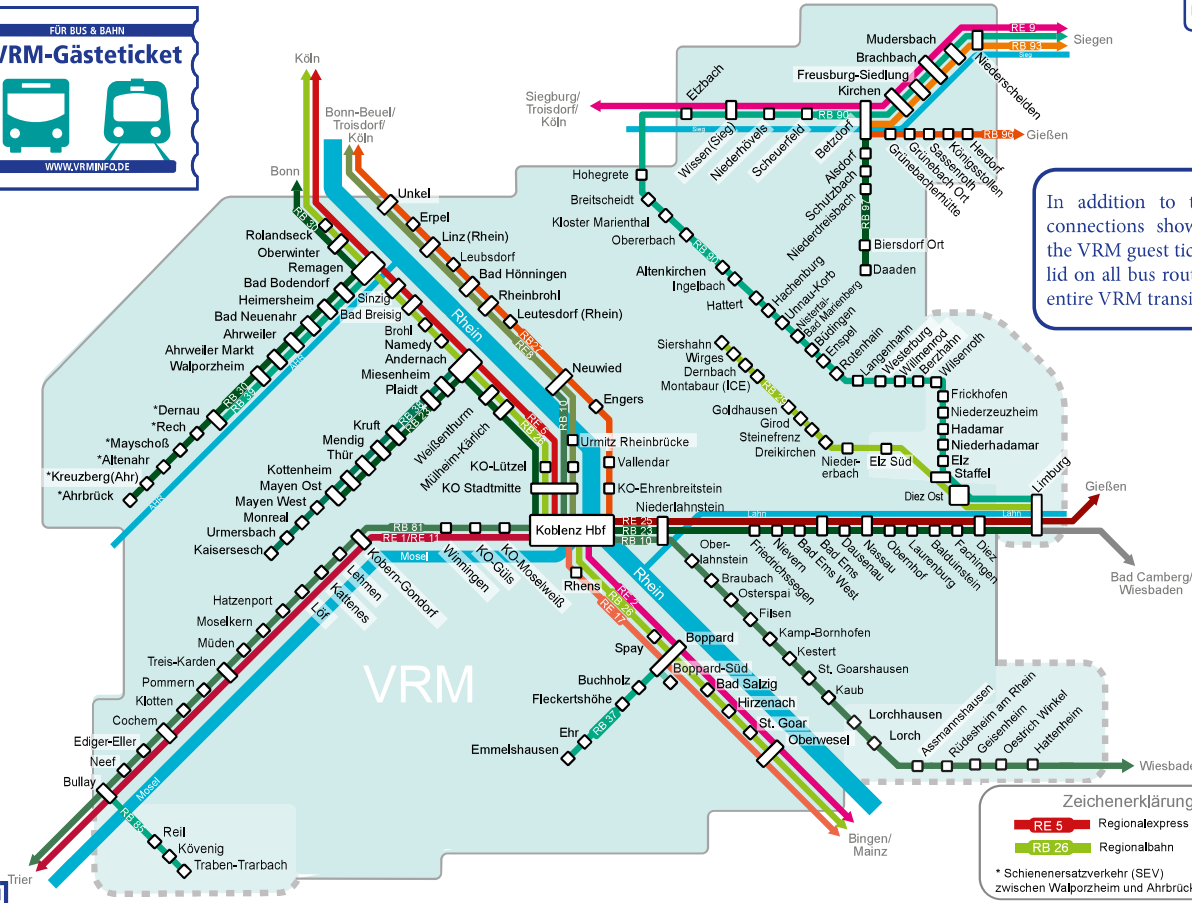
Please carry the VRM-Gästeticket and this leaflet with you at all times during your stay, as well as a valid photo ID. Each person must hold a guest ticket.

The VRM-Gästeticket entitles you to use local public transport in the VRM area and to the Hessian train stations of Lorchhausen, Lorch, Assmannshausen, Rüdesheim am Rhein, Geisenheim, Oestrich-Winkel and Hattenheim free of charge. Overnight guests with the VRM guest ticket can use all buses and trains in "RMV area 63", which includes the Municipalities of Lorch, Rüdesheim, Geisenheim and Oestrich-Winkel, use without additional payment.

Please remember to purchase a connecting ticket when leaving the VRM area by bus or train.



INFO TO VRM-GASTTICKET



In addition to the train connections shown there, the VRM guest ticket is valid on all bus routes in the entire VRM transit area.

Terms of use for Bus & Train

The VRM-Gästeticket is valid only for local public transport of the VRM (in 2nd class train carriages – not in Inter City or Inter City Express trains).

The VRM-Gästeticket is only valid when fully completed (the name and the place of residence of the guest must be entered along with the arrival and departure date). If the departure date has not been decided on in advance, your host will enter the expected date of your departure. If you should stay longer than expected, you will receive a new VRM-Gästeticket. Subsequent changes to the VRM-Gästeticket make it invalid for any use as an authorisation to public transport.

The VRM-Gästeticket is valid for passenger transport. The transport of bicycles is free of charge on weekdays after 09:00 and all day on Sundays and public holidays – insofar as the capacity of the trains or buses allows it.

The respective tariff regulations of the Rhine-Moselle Transport Association (VRM) apply to the carriage of animals. Travelers may, without having a legal entitlement to take dogs with them free of charge if this does not jeopardize the safety and order of the company. Dogs must be kept on a short leash. In addition, dogs that could endanger fellow passengers must wear a muzzle.
