

The VRM-guest ticket is valid only for local public transport of the VRM (in 2nd class train carriages – not in Inter City or Inter City Express trains).

The VRM-guest ticket is only valid when fully completed (the name and the place of residence of the guest must be entered along with the arrival and departure date). If the departure date has not been decided on in advance, your host will enter the expected date of your departure. If you should stay longer than expected, you will receive a new VRM-guest ticket. Subsequent changes to the VRM-guest ticket make it invalid for any use as an authorization to public transport.

The VRM-guest ticket is valid for passenger transport. The transport of bicycles is free of charge on weekdays after 09:00 and all day on Sundays and public holidays – insofar as the capacity of the trains or buses allows it.

The respective tariff regulations of the Rhine-Moselle Transport Association (VRM) apply to the carriage of animals. Travelers may, without having a legal entitlement, take dogs with them free of charge, if this does not jeopardize the safety and order of the company. Dogs must be kept on a short leash. In addition dogs, that could endanger fellow passengers, must wear a muzzle.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Dear guests,

the accommodation services within the VRM region participating in the VRM-guest ticket scheme provide a special service for you during your stay! You will receive a VRM-guest ticket from your accommodation service.

What does the VRM-guest ticket offer?

- Free use of local public transport in the VRM area and Hessian railroad stations: Lorchhausen, Lorch, Assmannshausen, Rüdesheim on Rhine, Geisenheim, Oestrich-Winkel and Hattenheim.
- Free use of buses and trains in the "RMV area 63", which includes the municipalities of Lorch, Rüdesheim, Geisenheim and Oestrich-Winkel.
- Free use of lines 700/777 (Gerolstein-Cochem) and 720 (Traben-Trarbach - Bullay)
- Use of ferries: Linz-Kripp, Remagen-Erpel and Koblenz-Ehrenbreitstein.
- Use of the fortress elevator Ehrenbreitstein and 20% discount on a ticket for the Brohltal Railway / Vulkan-Expreß.

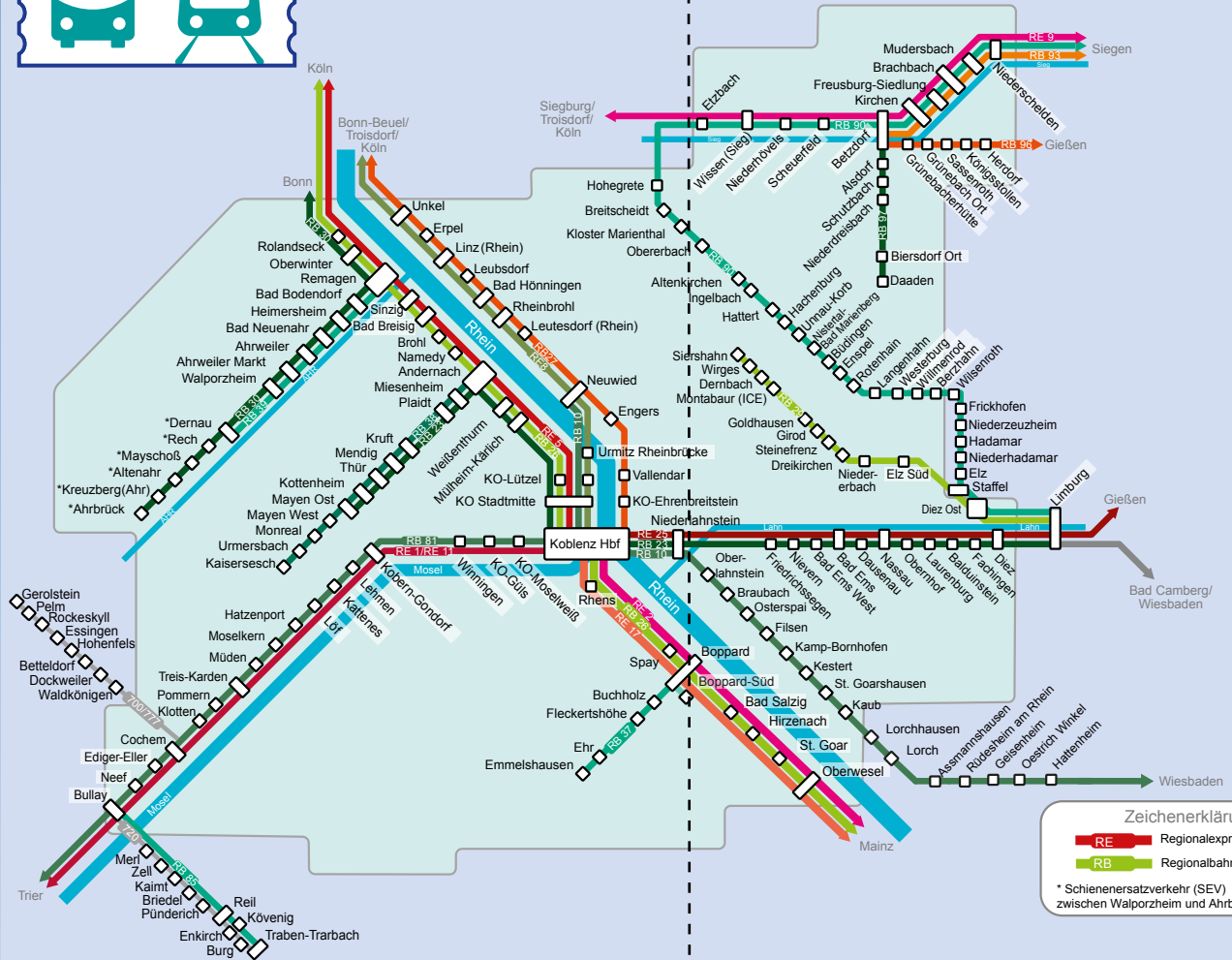
How do I get the VRM-guest ticket?

- You cannot buy the VRM-guest ticket. You can only get it from your host.

What do you need to know?

- Period of validity: period of stay.
- The VRM-guest ticket is not transferable; a photo ID must be carried.
- One VRM-guest ticket per person.
- When leaving the area of validity by bus and train a connecting ticket must be purchased.
